2022–23 Clergy Scholarship Application

As funds are available, BHSC is happy to offer BHSC Clergy Scholarship Awards to those who work in full-time ministry with a local church.

SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

- Those in full-time ministry at a local church who have children enrolled in BHSC for the 2022–23 academic year will receive 50% tuition remission on any class with a minimum of six non-staff/non-clergy students enrolled.
- No tuition remission will be offered for classes with fewer than six non-staff/non-clergy students enrolled.
- Applications are considered in the order that they are received, as long as funds are available.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Clergy scholarship will be for those serving at a local church in full-time ministry.
- Applicants must provide a letter from its employer verifying full-time ministerial status.
- Minimum enrollment of 3 classes per student is required for scholarship eligibility. Tuition-free courses do not count toward the minimum-enrollment eligibility threshold.
- Families who receive a BHSC scholarship award are expected to fulfill all required volunteer hours and are ineligible for the parent volunteer “buy out” option.

Generic Eligibility Requirements and Deadlines

The Bluebonnet community is proud to include families from a wide variety of places of origin, walks of life, and cultural backgrounds. We warmly welcome scholarship applicants who share the [BHSC vision](#), who affirm [BHSC Creed & Principles](#), and who agree to fulfill the [parent/guardian responsibilities](#). To be eligible for the scholarship award, the applicant, if not already enrolled, must also submit [this scholarship application](#) and [all three parts](#) of the BHSC [enrollment application](#) by or on **April 29, 2022**, attend a [required](#) information session by **May 26, 2022**, participate in the admissions family interview by **June 7, 2022**, and submit enrollment paperwork and registration fees by **June 15, 2022**.

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY: It is the policy of BHSC to admit homeschooling families and students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally made available to families and students. DEADLINES For full-year (Fall 2022–Spring 2023) enrollment, **final deadline for all requirements is June 15 and as described above**. For mid-year (Spring 2023) enrollment, all requirements must be met by **December 1**. **Extensions or exceptions to these guidelines will not be granted. APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications are automatically accepted upon verification of employment and availability of funds. A confirmation letter will be sent to the applicant within two weeks of the application.
